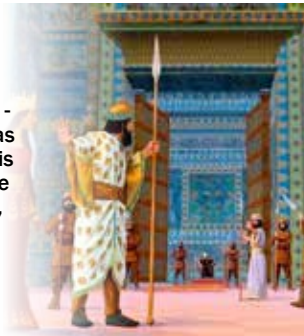


HER PERSISTENCE - on the third day
