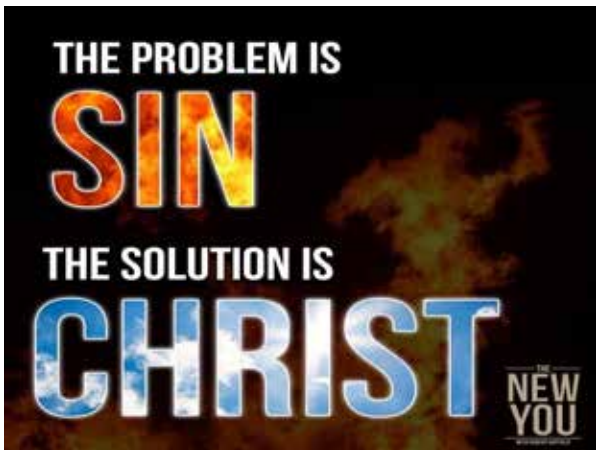



### THE PARADOX OF OUR AGE


WE HAVE BIGGER HOUSES, BUT SMALLER FAMILIES;


