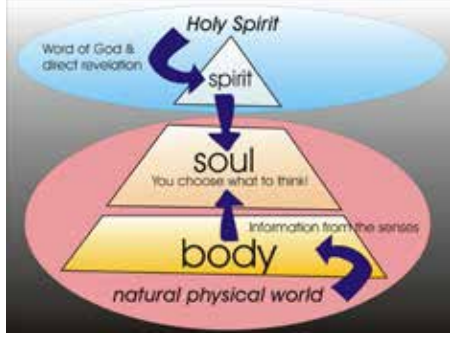


# WHAT HAPPENS TO A PERSON WHEN THEY DIE?



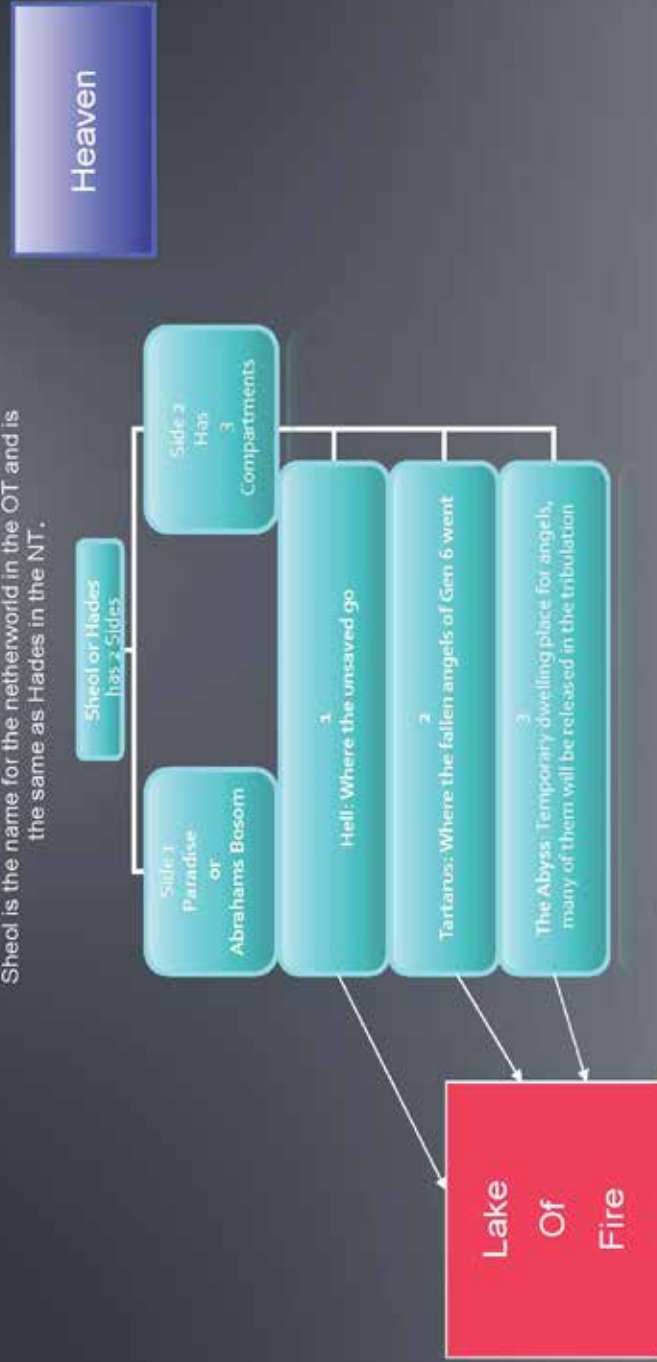
Spirit	Soul	Body

## Spirit World Destinations after Death

Sheol is the name for the netherworld in the OT and is the same as Hades in the NT.



When an Old Testament Saint died, his body went into the ground and his soul went to Abraham's Bosom because the sacrifices were insufficient to get him into Heaven. They were sufficient to keep him out of Hell. Their sins have to be removed the same way ours are, by the blood of the Lord Jesus Christ. The Old Testament Unsaved who died went to Hell. When Christ died he went to Hades (side 1), not Hell to free the captives. Today when a New Testament Saint dies his body goes into the ground and his soul goes straight to Heaven. The unbelievers go straight to Hell. After the 1,000 year reign of Christ on the earth (Millennium), the inhabitants of Hell, Tartarus, and the Abyss will be cast into the **Lake of Fire**. (The Greek word is Gehenna which means a burning garbage dump)
